Visa information

The student visa should be obtained in student's home country.

In order to apply for the visa, the student is required to present a Letter of Acceptance issued by the University Finis Terrae at the Chilean Embassy or Consulate. Once in Chile, the student is required to register the visa at *Policía de Investigaciones* and to apply for a temporary ID Card at the *Registro Civil* within 30 days of arrival.
